 - Or be actively involved in the Equine Industry.
- Winner must use the Scholarship funds toward their first semester at an accredited college/university

Application Process

- Complete Entry application
- Complete Essay based on one of the topics from the list on the previous page □ Essay must be longer than 250 words but no more than 500 words

Specifics

- Winner to be chosen based on criteria set by the Twin Valley Riding Club membership
- Valid entries include completed application and one completed essay

- Student must use the scholarship for their first semester's tuition at an accredited college/university
